

# Garland Beats Carrollton Hi

GARLAND, Texas, Nov. 18.—The Garland High School Owls defeated the Carrollton Lions Friday night, 25 to 6, in their final grid game of the season. The locals tallied in the initial quarter when they drove down the field on the kickoff from their own 35-yard line. They scored again early in the second quarter with Lander carrying over following another drive from the Lions' 40-yard line. The Lions' only touchdown of the game came early in the second quarter following an intercepted pass. They took to the air and completed three straight passes down to the Owl 4-yard line and then Latham carried over in two tries.
