

Grand Prairie Rallies, Wins By 15-7 Tally

Tiger Eleven Makes Use of Power, Trims Carrollton Gridders

The Grand Prairie High School eleven came from behind to defeat the Carrollton Tigers, 15 to 7, in a district game at the Carrollton field Friday night.

Almost before the spectators were comfortably seated, Gammons passed thirty-five yards to Kenipe for the touchdown and Latham made the try for extra point to place Carrollton in an early lead.

Both teams played straight football in the second quarter and late in the period Grand Prairie drove to the opposition's 25 but lost the ball on downs.

Trailing, 7-0, Grand Prairie drove to the Carrollton 5 on a series of power plays with Stamper, Grand Prairie back, making most of the gains. Stamper fumbled on the next play and Latham of Carrollton recovered over the goal for a safety, which made the score 7 to 2.

Still sticking to power plays, Grand Prairie recovered a fumble on the opponents' 20 and Stamper plowed down the field for a touchdown. He passed to Lowe over the goal for the extra point.

Grand Prairie drove to the Carrollton 20 and a penalty for holding advanced the ball to the 5. Stamper again ripped the opposing line to threads and raced over for the tally. The try for point was no good.

Stamper and Lowe were outstanding for Grand Prairie and Dickison, Gammons, Latham and Gentry starred for Carrollton.
