

BRYAN ADAMS BEATS LIONS

CARROLLTON, Texas.—Bryan Adams' Big Green football team blended a large portion of sound grid knowledge with a dash of beginner's luck en route to a 20-12 win over Carrollton's Lions here Friday night.

The game marked Adams' entry into the legendary Texas interscholastic football picture, and the triumph was well-earned.

By the same token, the Lions were a much-improved ball club

when he cracked through tackle, picked up a key block from Larry Mosely and skipped 74 yards to a TD. His try for point was wide and Adams led, 13-6.

The teams traded last period touchdowns, with the visitors scoring first.

A wobbly punt by Adams' Jim Phillips landed on the Carrollton 10, and brushed against Safety Man Mike Shackelford. Ivy Connor, an Adams wingman, out-fought Shackelford for possession and the winners turned the break into a TD moments later. Mike Howard falled on a sweep around right end and Shelton passed to Jerry Hawkins for the point.

The Lions battled back for their second score following the ensuing kickoff. Quarterback Butch Potts pitched out to Moseley who turned the right-hand corner for 12 yards and a TD to terminate a 58-yard push.

Chambers attempt to run across the point was a yard short of the mark and that wound things up.

over the outfit which dropped a 10-0 decision to title-conscious Richardson a week ago.

Adams scored on the first play of the second quarter to pile up a lead it never relinquished. The touchdown climaxed a 37-yard drive which came on the heels of a 9-yard punt by Carrollton's diminutive Kenny Chambers—probably the finest back on the field Friday night.

It took 10 plays to negotiate the distance, and Larry Brown took it the last three yards on a handoff from Quarterback Bill Shelton. Marv Brandon plunged over for the point.

Adams increased its advantage by six points in the third quarter when Brown rammed over from the 2, fumbled when hit and recovered the ball in the end zone.

Chambers put the Lions back in contention three plays later,
