

# Strong Carrollton Gridders Invade Mesquite Tonight

The powerful Carrollton High School football team, mentored by Morris (Fannie) Roach, plays the Mesquite High eleven on the Mesquite field Friday night in a crucial District 14-A game.

Coach O'Dell Sikes' gridgers, possible District 14-A champions this season, bested Wills Point, 12 to 0, in a nonconference game last week and Carrollton, boasting an impressive record the last three seasons, had little trouble in winning from the Woodrow Wilson B team of Dallas, 46 to 0.

To date Mesquite has amassed ninety-three points and has not been scored on while Carrollton has run up 246 points and has allowed

the opposition but forty in seven games played this year.

In the only other district scrap scheduled in District 14-A this week the Buckner Home eleven plays the Garland Owls at Garland Friday night. Last week Garland took an easy decision from Irving in a conference scrap. The score was 29 to 0. Buckner Home, tutored by G. S. Taylor, won from the hapless Pleasant Grove eleven, 33 to 7.

Coach Pat Jameson's high-touted Lancaster High School gridgers, leader in District 16-B, play the West team at Lancaster Friday night in a nonconference game. Lancaster won from Richardson, 19 to 0, last week and is heavy favorite to cop the district championship.
