

# Carrollton Plays Garland for Title

CARROLLTON, Texas, Nov. 21.—The Garland Owls and Carrollton Lions, both undefeated in the entire season, will square off Friday at 8 p.m. on Ramsey Field here for the District 15-A championship.

With the Owls having piled up 100 points to their opponents' 18 in conference play and Carrollton counting 92 to 6, a fast, hard-fought battle is expected. Each nipped the Grand Prairie Gophers, 6 to 0, indicating a toss-up.

Red-headed Bobby Griffin is the Garland mainspring, ably assisted in the backfield by Motley, Shugart and Bittle, and in the line by Granstaff and Ford. Carrollton stakes her hopes on Billy Colwell, working in the backfield with Williams, Moore and Richardson, behind a fine line that is built around Salmon, Ewing, McInnish and Lederman.
